Unless otherwise set out, scholarships will be available for use for the Fall 2016, Spring 2017 and/or Summer 2017 semesters. All applicants will be notified by mail upon completion of review.

A.H. BEAN ADULT EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling full-time who is 25 years old or older. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Four \$4000 scholarships)

ABRASLEY-SHELTON ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a second year student enrolled in the A.D.N. Program, with priority given to a married student with cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above. The award may be applied toward tuition, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

ALABAMA ONE CREDIT UNION CHARTER MEMBERS SCHOLARSHIP

For a member of the Alabama One Credit Union. Applicants must include proof of membership obtained from the Credit Union. Applicants must be a student enrolling full-time and have and maintain a 3.0 GPA. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (Two \$1,500 scholarships)

ALABAMA ONE CREDIT UNION VOLUNTEERS SCHOLARSHIP

For a member of the Alabama One Credit Union. Applicants must include proof of membership obtained from the Credit Union. Applicants must be a student enrolling full-time and have and maintain a 3.0 GPA. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (Two \$1500 scholarships)

CHAMPION SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolled full time during the time of the award in the machine tool or CNC program with a demonstrated need for financial assistance. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$1,000 scholarship)

CHARLES W. DENNIS MEMORIAL ENDOWED PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student seeking a career in technical theatre or related field. Students must receive a recommendation from his or her high school or college teacher that addresses relevant experience, abilities and aspirations in technical theatre or related field. Student must have and maintain a "B" average. Potential Candidates must have an in-person interview with staff members of Theatre Tuscaloosa to review his or her relevant experience. Contact Theatre Tuscaloosa for information regarding the interview. Recipient will be required to work 16 hours per week in the scene shop and as a crew member on at least one Theatre Tuscaloosa or Shelton State theatrical production each fall and spring semester while on scholarship. Award is open to graduating high school students, students already enrolled at Shelton State, or college students transferring to Shelton State. Priority will be given to previous awardees of the scholarship. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$5,000 scholarship)

CLENY RENFROE NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time nursing student. Must have and maintain at least a 3.0/4.0 GPA. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Two \$1,000 scholarships)

CLYDE PRICE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolled full-time at Shelton State Community College during the time the award will be used. Student must have and maintain a 3.0 or above GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

DR. AND MRS. JOHN N. TODD III ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling full-time. Applicant must demonstrate financial need and community involvement. Applicant must have and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. The award shall be split between the Fall and Spring semesters. (One \$1,200 scholarship: to be distributed \$600 per semester)

DR. CORDELL AND MARIE WYNN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling full-time. Selection based on grades and financial need. Student must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Two \$1,000 scholarships)

DRS. RANDALL AND MICHELE JARRELL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time first generation college student. Student must have and maintain B average. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. Applicant must be from the Shelton State service area. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

EASTMEN RESINS, INC. SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student from Hale County. Priority given to graduating seniors from high schools located in Hale County. Applicants must have an overall 3.0/4.0 or above GPA for senior year of high school. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$1,000 scholarship)

EDWIN AND CECELIA ASHTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a LPN pursuing a RN degree, with priority given to a student employed in a Tuscaloosa County Nursing Home as a LPN. Must be enrolling full time at SSCC. Award may be applied toward tuition, books or fees. (Two \$1,800 scholarships)

ERIN MARIA MALONE ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling at least half-time in a technical, occupational, or academic program. Priority given to a recent graduate of the GED programs of West Alabama. Include dated documentation of GED. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

JOYCE KELLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student with a 3.0 or better GPA demonstrating a need for financial assistance. Student must demonstrate a high level of integrity as indicated by two letters of character references. Student must demonstrate active church participation as indicated by two letters of recommendation from church officials. Student must maintain 3.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

KAREEM MCNEAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

For a physically challenged student enrolling at least half-time. Applicants must have and maintain a 3.0 or above GPA. Documentation of a physical challenge must be provided. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$1000 scholarship)

KERRY WELBORN BOOK SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling full-time. Must be a graduating senior from Hillcrest High School. Applicant with 2.0 GPA or better during senior year and demonstrating financial need will be given priority. Award may be applied toward books or program required supplies. (One \$250 scholarship)

MADEL PEARSON AND JOY DENDY TUSCALOOSA MUSIC CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

For an outstanding freshman or sophomore interested in pursuing a career in music education or performance. Student must receive a recommendation from the music faculty committee based on the student's performance on his/her fall semester jury, NATS preview concert performance, or on his/her audition for a SSCC Performing Arts Scholarship. Contact the Music Department for further information. Recipient will be required (if invited) to perform at the Tuscaloosa Music Club's Spring Meeting. (One \$300 scholarship)

McABEE CONSTRUCTION/SOUTHERN HEAT EXCHANGER SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling in the Drafting Technology Program. Applicant must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (One \$500 scholarship)

ROBERT MICHAEL ECHOLS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student demonstrating financial need. Student must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, books, fees or program required supplies. (Two \$1000 scholarships)

STACY CROCKER NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

For a full time nursing student. Applicant must include evidence of acceptance to the Nursing Program and must maintain an overall 3.0 or above GPA. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

STEVEN AND FRANCES RUMSEY SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling full-time. Must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA or above and demonstrate financial need. Student must be and remain in good citizenship standing with the school they are attending. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

THOMAS AND KAY UMPHREY PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a student demonstrating academic excellence, merit, and financial need. Must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (One \$1,000 scholarship)

TURNER ENDOWED VETERANS SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling part-time with priority to a Veteran who qualifies for Chapter 30: Montgomery G.I. Bill. Student must be an Alabama resident. Student must be enrolled in 3 or more credit hours for the qualifying semester(s). Award may be applied toward tuition or fees. (Five \$1000 scholarships: to be distributed \$500 per semester)

TUSCALOOSA BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL WOMEN'S ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP HONORING DR. MINNIE C. MILES AND SUE MCLEOD

For a student who graduated from a High School located in Tuscaloosa County or received their GED. Priority given as follows: 1. To the student who received the scholarship the year before, 2. To members of the Tuscaloosa Business & Professional Women's Club, 3. To a female student 25 years of age or older. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

WAYNE B. BOTELER MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student enrolled in the LPN Program. Student must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (One \$1000 scholarship)

ALEXANDER ADULT LEARNING SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student 35 years old or older. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

ALLEN LAYSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a student from West Alabama with priority to students from Pickens County. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. Applicants must have and maintain a 3.0 or above GPA. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

ANDY POTTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Priority given to a graduate/graduating senior of Berry High School. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Two \$1,000 scholarships)

B.A.P. SERVICES, INC. WELDING SCHOLARSHIP

For a current welding student at Shelton State Community College who is continuing their welding education and requires financial assistance. A written recommendation from the student's welding instructor is required. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Two \$500 scholarships)

BBVA COMPASS BANK SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling in a business or business-related program. Priority will be given to BBVA Compass Bank employees and their families. Applicants must include letter to demonstrate employment. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. Award shall be split between the Fall and Spring semesters. (One \$600 scholarship)

BERNICE BUTLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a student from West Alabama enrolling full-time. The applicant must have and maintain at least a 3.0/4.0 GPA. The applicant must have documented participation in community service, civic and/or church activities. Applicants must provide a signed letter summarizing participation. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Two \$1,000 scholarships)

BEVERLY COOK CHILD DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP [NEW]

For a student currently enrolled in the CHD AAS Program. Student must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Student may apply after completing at least one semester in the AAS program. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$350 scholarship)

BILLIE SUE BROWN MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

For an outstanding freshman or sophomore student interested in pursuing a career in music education or performance. Student must receive a recommendation from the music faculty committee based on the student's performance at the SSCC performing Arts Auditions. Sophomore's performance can be based on their fall semester jury, musicale or NATS performance. Contact the Music Department for information regarding the audition. Student must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 GPA. The scholarship may be renewed for the recipient for the following school year based on the recommendation of the music faculty committee. (One \$4,000 scholarship to be distributed - \$2,000 per the Fall and Spring semesters)

C.A. & HATTIE B. FREDD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a student who has, or will graduate from Green, Hale, Pickens, Sumter or Tuscaloosa County high school. The student may already be enrolled at SSCC. The student must have and maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average. The student must be and remain in good citizenship standing with the school they are attending and must have no current or prior citation for violating any school policies and/or codes relating to conduct or discipline. Student must submit a letter from the school they are currently attending indicating good citizenship standing. The student must be enrolled full time at SSCC during the time that the award will be used. Priority will be given to a student enrolling in a technical program. Scholarship and leadership shall also be considered. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$1,000 scholarship)

CARLA MATHEWS SCHOLARSHIP

For a Tuscaloosa County High School graduating senior planning to enter nursing studies. Must be enrolling full-time. Selection based on grades, merit and financial need. Student must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

EUGENE AND ELAINE JARRELL MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a student who is 30 years old or older. Applicant must be from the Shelton State service area. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. Student must have and maintain a B average or above. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

FANG PHYSICS SCHOLARSHIP

For a current Shelton student studying science with a preference for Physics. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

GINA MIERS SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling full-time. Must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA or above and demonstrate financial need. Student must be and remain in good citizenship standing with the school they are attending. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, book or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

GORDON AND ANN ROSEN ENDOWED NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolled in the Nursing Program. Applicant must include evidence of acceptance to the LPN or RN Program, and must have and maintain an overall 3.0 or above GPA. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$850 scholarship)

HALL-TAYLOR CONSTRUCTION COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP

For a graduating senior at Hillcrest High School enrolling full-time. The award may be applied toward tuition, books, fees or program required supplies. The award shall be split between the Fall and Spring semester. (One \$2,700 scholarship to be distributed \$1,350 per semester)

HAROLD JAMES ENDOWED TECHNICAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a student enrolling in one of the college's technical programs. Students must show need, along with interest in a vocational technical program. Student must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 average. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (One \$500 scholarship)

HELEN H. AND JOHN K. MCKINLEY CULINARY ARTS-HOSPITALITY SCHOLARSHIP

For a student having successfully completed at least two semesters in the Culinary Arts Program at Shelton State Community College and is pursuing a degree in the Culinary Arts Program. Applicant must include letter of recommendation from Culinary Arts Program instructor. Student must receive NO federal government assistance and NO federally sponsored student loan. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$1,000 scholarship)

HELEN H. MCKINLEY EXCELLENCE AWARD FOR PRACTICAL NURSING SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time student having completed at least one semester at Shelton State Community College. Applicant must include evidence of acceptance to the Practical Nursing Program, and must have and maintain an overall 3.0 or above GPA. The award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (Two \$1,000 scholarships)

JamisonMoneyFarmer PC SCHOLARSHIP

For an employee or dependent of an employee of JamisonMoneyFarmer. Applicant must have and maintain a 3.0/4.0 GPA. Must have letter from company verifying employment. Award shall be split between Fall and Spring semester. (One \$800 scholarship: to be distributed \$400 per semester)

JOHN AND ANNE GLANKLER MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a student who is 30 years old or older. Applicant must be from the Shelton State service area. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. Student must have and maintain a B average or above. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)

JOY PEARSON DENDY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

For a full time student in the fine arts program. Priority will be given to a student majoring in music. Student must have and maintain a 3.0 GPA. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees or books. (One \$1000 scholarship)

WEST ALABAMA HEALTH COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. For a student currently enrolled in a health professions degree program at Shelton State Community College, or an applicant to one of the degree programs that has been accepted for the following term; however, students in the Medical Transcription course of study shall be excluded from being eligible for this scholarship. Priority will be given to applicants that are students obtaining an education which will enable them to return to the workforce, or students who are also parents and who are pursuing a degree to better provide for their family;
- 2). The applicant must be a resident of one of the following counties at the time of application: Bibb, Hale, Fayette, Greene, Lamar, Marengo, Pickens, Sumter, or Tuscaloosa counties. Proof of residency must accompany the application, and such proof may be a current drivers' license or other comparable documentation;
- 3). An applicant must submit a written statement of at least three (3) full paragraphs in length, detailing how the scholarship would positively affect their ability to pursue the degree being sought by the applicant, if the applicant is chosen for the scholarship. Priority will be given to applicants that illustrate how this scholarship will affect their ability to pay for an education they would not otherwise be able to afford, or which will ease the burden on themselves or their family due to their current situation in life. Applicants should also be able to identify their career goals, and whether they plan to remain in the West Alabama area after completing their degree;
- 4). An applicant must submit their transcripts and all documentation required by Shelton State. A minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale is required, or the equivalent academic standing based upon the applicants prior educational history.
- 5). The applicant must also provide a recommendation from someone who is familiar with the applicant's career goals, and their commitment to the health profession within which the applicant is pursuing their degree. If a recent high school graduate, the applicant should provide a recommendation from a teacher or other advisor that has knowledge of their desire to obtain the degree sought, and their dedication to actually enter the profession for which the degree is being sought. It is the desire of the West Alabama Health Council that students who receive this scholarship be committed to actually practice the profession which they are studying, so that the student can make a positive contribution to the health and well being of the citizens of West Alabama. (Two \$1,000 scholarships)

WILLIAM J. QUIMBY MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

For a full-time Electrical Technology or Industrial Electronics Technology student that has completed a minimum of thirty credit hours in the Electrical Technology program, Industrial Electronics Technology program or a combination of these two programs (ELT/ILT COURSES) with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above. A statement of financial need to be included in essay. A written recommendation from the ELT/ILT faculty committee is required. Award may be applied toward tuition, fees, books or program required supplies. (One \$500 scholarship)
