

PAUL TURNER ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Each year, the Pell City Rotary Club will award a \$1,500.00 scholarship to one outstanding senior. A check for this amount will be made payable to the college or university of the student's choice and the check can be used for any purpose including tuition, books, room and board etc. An additional \$1,500.00 per year will be awarded over the next three years as long as the student is a full time student, in good standing with the college or university as well as progressing at grade level. A scholarship will not be renewed for a student who chooses to only enroll part time.

To qualify as a scholarship candidate, a student must fulfill the following requirements:

1. The student must complete the application process. The application must be submitted to the counselor's office by the deadline date. This year's deadline will be April 5, 2021.
2. The student must have a minimum cumulative academic grade point average of 3.5.
3. The student must have achieved a minimum ACT composite score of 25 or a minimum SAT total score of 1100.
4. Three letters of recommendation. At least one letter must be from someone outside of the Pell City School System.
5. The scholarship will be chosen by the Rotary Club Scholarship Committee based on the criteria given to the committee. The Pell City Rotary Club will present the scholarship each year at the annual Academic Banquet. The club must be notified of the proposed recipient at least 14 days prior to the Academic Banquet.
6. There shall be no criteria established in the selection process of this award which would serve to discriminate against any person based upon race, color, religion, sex, national origin, handicap, or familial status.
