JSCC Ambassador Information

The Jefferson State Ambassadors serve as official hosts and hostesses for all Jefferson State locations and community sponsored events. Most Ambassadors will receive a semester by semester scholarship up to 2 years that includes tuition and fees (*books not included*).

Newly selected Ambassadors will be chosen by a selection committee based on their application, interview, GPA, letter of recommendation, leadership skills, interest in student involvement and future goals.

If selected, each Ambassador will be required to do the following:

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Abide by the JSCC Ambassador Demerit System and Code of Conduct
- Must enroll and complete a total of 24 hours for the fall and spring semesters combined (unless program requirements differ)
- Attend a Mandatory Ambassador Orientation/Workshop
- Host various college events, this includes: President Receptions/Events, Graduation Ceremonies, Honors Convocation, Scholar's Bowl Tournaments, New Student Orientations, and any other event assigned by the Advisor

ALL events assigned by the Advisor are MANDATORY for Ambassadors to attend

- Work a minimum of 5 service work hours per week in a designated area on campus (assigned by the Ambassador Advisor)
- Complete a one hour Ambassador Humanities Course in the fall and spring semesters
- Help at ALL New Student Orientations
- Conduct campus tours
- Attend Leadership Conferences and Seminars
- Attend an annual Ambassador Retreat
- Coordinate and participate in fundraising events
- Must travel to various Jefferson State Campuses and the surrounding communities
- Be available for daytime, evening and weekend events (both on and off campus)
- Participate in and coordinate community service projects
- Be involved with other student organizations and events

The JSCC Ambassador Organization is a prestigious group of individuals that display great leadership skills, academic success, and are self motivated. We are looking for students that demonstrate those qualities.

Once all interviews are complete, each applicant will receive a letter by mail within the next two weeks regarding their status with the Jefferson State Ambassador student organization.

All applicants that submit a **completed** application will be contacted for an individual interview. Any application that is received incomplete will NOT be contacted. Newly elected Ambassadors will be chosen by a selection committee based on their application, interview, GPA, letter of recommendation, leadership skills, interest in student involvement and future goals.

Ambassadors selected by the committee will be awarded a semester by semester Scholarship up to 2 years that includes tuition and fees (books are not included). In order to receive this scholarship, the student must be either a US citizen or permanent resident. To maintain this scholarship each Ambassador must abide by the following:

- The Jefferson State Ambassador Code of Conduct Policy Rules and Regulations
- Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Must enroll and complete a total of 24 hours for the fall and spring semesters combined (unless program requirements differ)
- Must be a US citizen or Permanent Resident

If selected, each Ambassador will be **required** to do the following:

- Attend a Mandatory Ambassador Orientation/Workshop (1 day)
- Complete service hours in a designated area on campus
- Complete a 1 hour credit Humanities Course in the fall and spring semesters
- Attend ALL college or community events assigned by the Ambassador Advisor (this
 includes President Receptions, Graduation Ceremonies, Honors Convocation, New
 Student Orientations, and any other school related function)
- Act as official hosts and hostesses of the college
- Be available for daytime, evening and weekend events
- Conduct campus tours for all JSCC locations
- Coordinate ALL JSCC New Student Orientations (this includes all 4 JSCC locations)
- Coordinate community service projects
- Help coordinate fundraising events
- Attend Leadership Conferences and Seminars
- Attend an Annual Ambassador Retreat (may include an overnight stay)
- Be involved with other student organizations and events
- Represent Jefferson State at all times

All JSCC Ambassadors are expected to represent our institution with pride at all times. Our current Ambassadors work very hard but they also have a lot of fun being a part of this group. We hope that you will help us find the right individuals for this organization!
