PELL CITY PAUL TURNER ROTARY CLUB SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

Each year Pell City High School, through the Pell City Rotary Club, will award a \$1500 scholarship to an outstanding senior. A check for this amount will be made payable to the college or university of the student's choice and applied toward the first year of tuition. An additional \$1,500 per year will be awarded over the next four years as long as the student remains in school.

A Scholarship Committee will select a recipient based on academic achievement, scores from aptitude tests, leadership activities, and special honors and awards received.

In order to qualify as a scholarship candidate, a student must fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. The student must complete the application process. The application must be submitted to the senior counselor by the dead-line date.
- 2. The student must have achieved a minimum cumulative academic grade point average of 90 (A-).
- 3. The student must have achieved a minimum ACT composite score of 25 or a minimum SAT total score of 1100.

Scoring criteria for the Scholarship Committee will be as follows: <u>Test Scores:</u> ACT composite score of 25 - 5 points plus one point for each

point above 25.

SAT total score of 1100 - 5 points plus one point for every 50 points above 1100.

Grade Point Average: 90 (A-)
